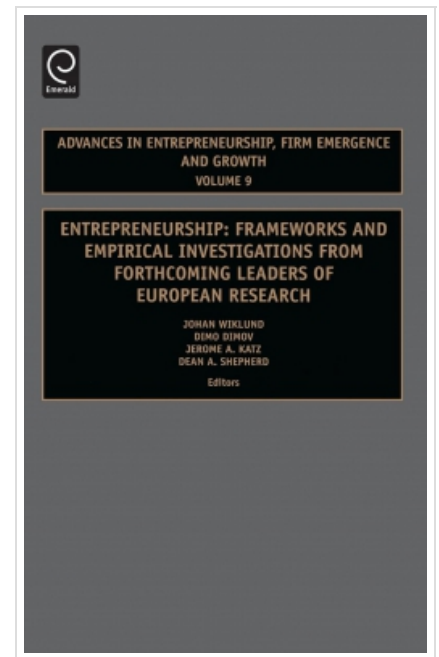

In doing so, the field of entrepreneurship will grow in terms of the range of ideas, data sources, and techniques.
