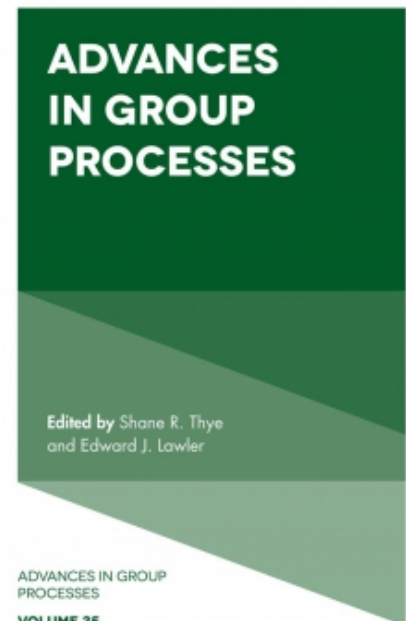

About the Book
